Twelfth Step Within Committee

Hello, friends! My name is Karen B - I am a compulsive overeater and the chairperson of your Twelfth Step Within Committee.

One purpose of the Twelfth Step Within Committee of the Ottawa District Intergroup is to support existing OA members and to strengthen the fellowship by sharing information and ideas that generate recovery.

Since March 2020, a large component of the Committee supporting the existing membership has been to maintain a list of available sponsors in the Ottawa area. While members are still encouraged to attend many meetings to find somebody who has what they want and ask that person to be their sponsor, Zoom meetings have presented challenges in doing this. On Zoom, remaining online to chat after meetings can be awkward for some, and more frequently, people are experiencing screen fatigue. The list of available sponsors has been very important in assisting members in finding a sponsor with whom they can work the Steps of our program.

As recovered, and recovering, compulsive overeaters, it is our privilege and responsibility to carry the message of recovery by being guides through the Twelve Steps that has brought us freedom and serenity. I would like to encourage all of you to prayerfully, and thoughtfully, consider and discuss with your own sponsor, making yourself available to sponsor. You can be a temporary sponsor to take somebody through their first 30 days or the first three Steps; you can be a food sponsor, a Step sponsor, or both. You can let the Committee know you are available to sponsor by emailing us at 12stepwithin@oa-ottawa.ca to be added to our list. We periodically contact available sponsors to make sure they wish to remain on the list.

Carrying the message of OA, paying back and forward to another still suffering member of OA, is not only our responsibility, but it brings us so much joy – the joy of being of service to our Higher Power and to our fellows – which in turn strengthens our own program of recovery.

Many blessings to you as we walk this road – TOGETHER!



The Convention was a resounding success with over 600 registrants. For the first time, Region 6 created a Facebook page advertising the Convention. There was a possible viewing of 96,000 Facebook users. There were between 900 and 1,000 clicks on the page. Around 350 sent a Facebook message to inquire about OA.



2021 Region 6 Fall Assembly - September 25

Claire L. and Danielle G. attended virtually as voting members for Ottawa District Intergroup (ODIG).

Election of Region 6 Board Officers for a two-year term

- Carmen D., from Intergroupe français de l'Outaouais, has been re-elected as Chair.
- Chuck F., from Central Ontario IG, was re-elected as Web/Publications Coordinator.
- Linda B., from Central Ontario, was elected Coordinator.
- Sue S., from Long Island NY, was elected Secretary.
- Two members, representing Region 6, were voted in to join the World Service Business Conference (WSBC) sub-committee to study motions during the upcoming WSBC taking place April 2022 in Albuquerque, New Mexico.

Public Information (PI) Blitz Fund

- For the 2021/2022 fiscal year the PI Blitz fund was approved at \$10,000 to be used in both the fall and spring assemblies. The following Intergroups submitted a request for Blitz funds:
- New York State Capital District \$2,500 (Facebook Ads)
 Southwestern Connecticut OA \$400 (Table at a Wellness Expo)
- Western Mass Intergroup \$2,100 (Billboards)

Proposal for restructuring the Board of Trustees

 A PowerPoint presentation was shown to the attendees on behalf of OA Board of Trustees restructuring Committee. A proposed plan is to reduce the number of Board of Trustees at the level of World OA. Many questions were given to the Region 6 Board of Trustee to bring back to the Committee working on this project. More to come.

Assembly Facts

- 37 Intergroups participated at the Fall Assembly.
- 50 eligible voting members plus alternative members and visitors attended the Assembly.
- Seven (7) first-time representatives attended the event.
- Spring Assembly 2022 will take place on April 2.
- Fall Assembly 2022 scheduled for September 23.
- PI Blitz proposals and travel scholarship applications to attend Spring Assembly are due **February 1, 2022**.

Twelve Steps Within (TSW)

Danielle G. joined the Twelve Steps Within (TSW) committee which was presented with the following request:

- The TSW Committee was asked if it would be possible for Region 6 to provide and manage a sponsor & sponsee bank/list.
- Consensus was to have sponsor banks at the level of Intergroups rather than regional level.
- The goal of the Committee is to prepare a plan to encourage Intergroups to create sponsor banks.
- The short-term action plan is to get samples of existing sponsor banks from various Intergroups and Regions.
